- Shaun Cerisano:
 - Shaun is a Philanthropy Manager with the BC Children's Hospital Foundation in Vancouver, where he manages all fundraising activities, including donor solicitation, fundraising events and programs, and more.
 - Shaun grew up with two brothers who had muscular dystrophy.
 - The BC Children's Hospital is among the top 5 in the world.
 - With advances in research the survival rate for children struggling with cancer has gone up from 50% in 1982 to currently 80-90%.
 - An estimated 14 children from Vancouver Island are submitted for treatment every day at the Children's Hospital, working in direct collaboration with Victoria General Hospital Pediatrics; therefore, Shaun considers the BC Children's Hospital a "local charity" and encouraged us to do so as well.
 - Donors—individual, business/corporate, festival, cause marketing—are essential to ensuring ongoing improvements in research and care at the hospital.
 - Shaun quotes, "The service you do for others is the rent you pay for your room here on earth." Muhammad Ali
