#### **Program Overview:**

#### (1) Vocational talk by Margaret Black

Margaret grew up on the family farm, in a house built by her great-grandfather in 1856. She shared her story of how a girl with a twin sister, born to a farming family in King, Ontario, became a pioneering lawyer, opening the first all-female law firm right after passing the Bar exam, practicing law for 15 years, and then returning to her hometown to become Mayor for 16 years until 2010. And after all that, returned to practice law.

Margaret helped move her son and his family to Victoria and she and her husband liked Oak Bay so much that they bought a home within 3 weeks of being here! Her grandchildren are 4 and 6 years old.

Margaret joined the Rotary Club of Oak Bay and is part of the youth services committee and the mentorship program.

## (2) Flag Program Presentation by Lorna:

#### Why we do it

The flag program is a major fundraiser for our club. Without these funds we cannot support projects in our community, so we need everyone's help.

#### What we raise:

Flag subscriptions are \$55 per year and we sell approximately 500 subscriptions.

We raise approximately \$25,000 annually!

#### How does it work:

We sell flag subscriptions in the community (friends, neighbours, co-workers, family)

Three times per year (May long weekend, July long weekend, and September long weekend), flag installers circulate the flags, placing them on subscribers' lawns, in their flower beds or in back gardens. Flags are installed a few days before each weekend and picked up a few days after each weekend.

#### What we need from club members:

- (1) Sell subscriptions (talk to people on your street, family etc.) Flag subscriptions are not limited to Oak Bay flags are installed throughout Greater Victoria
- (2) Volunteer as an installer or to assist an installer.
